TSAINA OR TSINA - THAT IS THE QUESTION

There are not a lot of controversies in Valdez, but when it comes to the new sign on the Richardson Highway, Valdezeans have a lot to say. A sign recently erected on the Richardson Highway reads Tsina. According to the Department of Transportation there are several variations of the spelling of the river depending on the location. Tsina Glacier is 0.5 miles West of Tsina River and 19 miles NE of Valdez. Thirty four miles NE of Valdez is the Tsaina. Tsaina is an Ahtena Indian name meaning "bent (crooked) river" and was named by F.C. Schrader, USGS, in 1898. According to DOT, there was also a telegraph station established here in 1902 by the U.S. Army, Signal Corps. It was officially called "Saina."
