SHELL'S DECISION TO ABANDON ARCTIC DRILLING THREATENS KEY PIPELINE

San Antonio Express News- An offshore discovery could have delivered a surge of crude for the 800-mile-long Trans-Alaska Pipeline System. It was originally built to ferry 2 million barrels of crude per day away from the North Slope oil fields, but is now carrying about a quarter of that as the nearby production declines. Every drop less oil in the pipeline means the crude moves slower and gets colder on its route from Prudhoe Bay Valdez, where it is loaded onto tankers and sent to the continental United States. 
