Still need good/new children’s coats and new or like new toys especially for infant to 3 and 7 and older. We do already have a lot of stuffed animals and don’t really need those.

We expect over 525 food basket requests (**another increase over last year which was a record year!**). A canned food drive at the high school, as well as continuous collection within the club, will provide some of the cans with about 20-30 cans per box with Key Club spending an additional \$12,000+ on more cans plus items to be added to the boxes (hams, flour, sugar, fruit, macaroni & cheese, crackers, peanut butter, cake mix & icing, vanilla wafers and more).
