

WILD COUNTRY 965'S LUCKY BUCK CONTEST

Official Rules:

- This contest and all rules are subject to the laws and hunting regulations of the state of New York. All contestants must be legally permitted to take deer according to the 2015 New York Hunting Regulations. Valid New York Farm permits are acceptable.
- 2. All animals must be legally harvested in New York State and hunters must provide hunting license if asked. Official weigh-ins will begin October 1st and end December 13th at:

3. All animals that are officially weighed in will be eligible for all prizes.

- 4. Contest will encompass all legal New York hunting seasons:
 - i. Bow 9/27 to 10/16
 - ii. Muzzle Loader 10/17 to 10/23
 - iii. Rifle 10/24 to 12/6
 - iv. Muzzle Loader 12/7 to 12/13
- Drawing for all prizes will be held on the week following the contest
 Grand Prize: Random draw among all hunters who officially weighed in an animal. \$1000.00 (USD)
 - Other prizes will be awarded at the end of the season dinner TBA.
- 6. To be entered into the Grand Prize hunters must officially weigh in at the weigh-in station listed in #2
- 7. All entries that do not win the Grand Prize will have a chance to win other prizes. Hunters may enter up to a maximum of 3 times. (Bow/Muzzleloader/Rifle)
- 8. Certain restrictions may apply to certain contests. All winners must grant an unlimited permission to use their names, characters, photographs, voices and likenesses in connection with promotion of this or other contests and must waive any claim of royalty, rights or remuneration for such use.
