
## JE CIRCUIT-RIDER'S GUIDE TO THE HELENOR SITES



## **Exact locations of the five Historic Sites** in the Helenor "Cluster"

- 1. The Interpretive Center at the Jasper County Historical Society Museum— 479 N. Van Rensselaer Street in Rensselaer. GPS reading: 40 56 26.24, -087 09 20.42
- 2. The Rosebud Schoolhouse at the County Fairgrounds. GPS reading: 40 56 25.83, -087 11 07.53
- 3. Helenor's grave site in Sandridge Cemetery on the <u>south</u> side of Jasper County Road West 250N, one-third mile east of CR N500W; her grave is in the southwest corner of the cemetery; GPS reading: 41 02 53.97, -087 08 09.56
- 4. and 5. The Alter stone house and Alter Cemetery on the south side of Jasper County Road West 1600S, 7/10 of a mile west of CR S880W; GPS reading: 40 46 44.42, -087 13 28.89

These five locations together are recognized by The United Methodist Church as Historic Site No. 487. A small marker denoting this honor is attached to the pillow stone at Helenor's graveside (SITE 3 on the map).
