



TORNADO TIPS

REMINDER: A FEMA-approved Safe Room or Storm Shelter is the best place to be in the event of a tornado. Reference our KTTS Safe Room Map at KTTS.com to find one closest to you.

IN YOUR HOME:

- Go to the basement or lowest room in your home or sturdy building.
- Take shelter in a windowless, interior room.
 - Bathroom, closet, hallway
- Cover yourself in coats or blankets that will protect you from debris.

ON THE ROAD:

- Never drive into the storm.
- Instead, pull over and get out of your car.
- Find a low-lying area, such as a ditch
- Never take cover under a bridge or overpass
 - Strong winds create a wind tunnel effect

Remember to always turn to KTTS when severe weather is approaching your area to stay up to date with the latest watches and warnings. In the event of a power outage, consider investing in a battery-operated radio or NOAA weather radio in order to get continuous information from KTTS and the National Weather Service.
