**CONSTITUTIONAL  
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

*Proposed by the 100th General Assembly  
(Second Regular Session)  
(SS 3 SJR 38)*

Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to:

- Ban gifts from paid lobbyists to legislators and their employees;
- Reduce legislative campaign contribution limits;
- Change the redistricting process voters approved in 2018 by:
  - (i) transferring responsibility for drawing state legislative districts from the Nonpartisan State Demographer to Governor-appointed bipartisan commissions;
  - (ii) modifying and reordering the redistricting criteria.
