WHEREAS, City Council therefore wishes to repeal Resolution 10478 and conclude the hearing process without further expense to the City.

PURPOSE: Repealing Resolution 10478 as to the conduct of Councilmember Jan Fisk referred to Hearing Examiner Kenneth Thompson pursuant to Section 2-60(o)(1) of the Code of the City of Springfield.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: In accordance with the provisions of Section 2-60(o) of the Code of the City of Springfield on October 7, 2019, City Council adopted Resolution 10478 appointing Kenneth Thompson as Hearing Examiner to investigate possible violations of the City Code and the City Charter by Councilmember Jan Fisk. Since that time the hearing process has gone forward and extensive evidentiary discovery and analysis has taken place, pre-hearing motions have been filed and the facts and circumstances of the matters at issue are now more fully understood.

On November 2, 2020, Councilmember Fisk voluntarily filed amended Personal Financial Disclosure forms. On November 2, 2020, J. Howard Fisk Limousines, Inc., voluntarily paid to the City funds associated with the transactions at issue in the amount of \$3,453.00. Based on these actions the requisite number of Councilmembers have signed a Withdrawal of the Letter of Referral and City Council wishes to repeal Resolution 10478 and conclude the hearing process without further expense to the City.

## WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR REFERRAL TO A HEARING EXAMINER OF ALLEGATIONS OF MISCONDUCT ON THE PART OF COUNCILMEMBER JAN FISK

On September 24, 2019, the requisite number of councilmembers submitted a Revised Request for Referral to a Hearing Examiner to investigate possible violations of the City Code and the City Charter by Councilmember Jan Fisk.

On October 7, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution 10478 confirming the Mayor's appointment of Kenneth Thompson as Hearing Examiner and called upon the Hearing Examiner to conduct an investigation into the matters identified in the Revised Request for Referral and Resolution.

Since that time, there has been extensive evidentiary discovery, which has helped clarify the nature and scope of the pertinent facts. And Councilmember Fisk, to her credit, voluntarily filed amended personal financial disclosure forms; and J. Howard Fisk Limousines, Inc., voluntarily paid to the City funds associated with the transactions at issue.

We believe all members of Council should use their best efforts to ensure that we are not a part of circumstances that could compromise the trust of those we serve or the high standards of integrity that our constituents are entitled to expect. The undersigned also believe that in light of the voluntary actions taken by Councilmember Fisk in an effort to remedy the issues raised in our Letter of Referral that it is now in the best interests of the City and its residents and taxpayers to bring these proceedings to a close. We thus now wish to withdraw the Request for Referral.

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
