

## LAST RIDER STANDING RULES

10-12-19

- 1. The contest will be limited to 100 participants.
- 2. All contestants must register, receive a copy of the rules and sign a waiver at the dealership during normal business hours between Tuesday, October 1, 2019 and the close of business October 4, 2019 or until 100 contestants have signed up, whichever happens first.
- 3. All contestants must present a state issued form of identification at the time of registration and the day the event begins.
- 4. The contest will begin at 11:00 am Saturday October 12, 2019 and will continue until a winner is declared.
- 5. Contestants will remain standing with at least one hand on the trailer or motorcycle at all times.
- 6. If a contestant removes both hands at the same time, they will be eliminated from the competition.

- 7. Elimination can only occur if the contestant voluntarily quits or a rule infraction is observed by a contest judge.
- 8. Dream Machines employees and associates will officially judge the contest. These judges redeem the right to alter or clarify rules at their sole discretion.
- 9. At each 3 hour interval, a whistle will sound signifying the beginning of a 15 break.
- 10. During the scheduled breaks, contestants can break contact with their objective and move freely around the area.
- 11. At the 14 minute mark of each break, a whistle will sound signifying there is one minute until the end of the break. Failure to have at least one hand back on the objective by the end of this whistle will cause the contestant to be eliminated from the contest.
- 12. The contest will continue until only 1 contestant remains. Only 1 prize will be awarded.
- 13. The winning contestant will be awarded a used Harley Davidson motorcycle determined by the owner prior to the event.
- 14. There are no warranties expressed or implied on the motorcycle awarded.
- 15. The winning contestant is solely responsible for any applicable taxes or registration fees for the motorcycle.
- 16. All contestants agree that their names and likeness can be used by Dream Machines of Kansas for any advertising or public relations programs.
- 17. Dream Machines of Kansas reserves the right to temporarily suspend the contest and move the competition to other areas in the Wichita metro area for advertising and promotional activities.
- 18. All contestants must sign a waiver releasing Dream Machines of Kansas from any legal or financial responsibility for any injuries that occur during the contest.
