DISPOSITION FOR ALCOHOL ORDINANCE VIOLATION

The City Commission held a special commission meeting on April 10, 2018 at 7:00 a.m. At the hearing the commissioners found that your admission of the violation was knowingly and voluntarily made and that it was sufficient to find that a violation of our alcohol ordinance occurred. The commissioners then voted on the following disposition:

- The American Legion Licensee will select seven days from April 10, 2018 to October 10, 2018. The Licensee will notify the Chief of Police by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 19, 2018 which days are selected. On those days from the time the American Legion normally opens, until 2:00 a.m. the following morning no alcohol can be served or consumed on the premises.
- 2. The American Legion will be placed on thirty-six months of probation, as set authorized by Valley City Municipal Code section 4-01-11(5), commencing on March 4, 2018. The following are additional conditions of this probation:
 - a. The licensee must obtain an identification scanner authorized by the Chief of Police within three months of today's date.
 - b. In addition to the provisions set forth in Valley City Municipal Code section 4-01-05(7), all employees regularly involved in the selling, serving, or pouring of alcohol must attend server training within three months of today's date.

3. The Licensee will be assessed a \$300 administrative penalty.



Warning of start of probation

WRITTEN WARNING NOTIFYING LICENSEE OF START OF PROBATION AS OF MARCH 4, 2018

On April 10, 2018, the City Commission held a special commission meeting where the commissioners accepted your admission of an alcoholic beverages ordinance violation. As part of the final disposition, the American Legion was placed on probation for thirty-six months as authorized by Valley City Municipal Code section 4-01-11(5).

Valley City Municipal Code section 4-01-11(5) provides as follows:

If a violation related to the sale of alcoholic beverages occurs by a licensee or licensee's employee, the following administrative fines, suspensions or revocations will be imposed:

- a. For a first violation, the licensee will receive a three hundred dollar (\$300) administrative penalty, in addition to any criminal penalties. The licensee will receive a written warning and the Probationary Period will begin as of the date of the offense. The City Commission also in its discretion [may] suspend the license.
- b. For a second violation within the Probationary Period, the licensee will receive a five hundred dollar (\$500) administrative penalty, in addition to any criminal penalty.
- c. For a third violation within the Probationary Period, the licensee will receive a \$1000 administrative penalty, in addition to any criminal penalty, and the alcohol license will be suspended for a period of one week or seven business days, whichever is longer.
- d. For a fourth violation within the Probationary Period, the licensee will receive a \$3000 administrative penalty, in addition to any criminal penalty, and the alcohol license will be revoked.

Therefore, as required by 4-01-11(5), YOU ARE HEREBY given written warning that the American Legion's probation period of thirty-six (36) months is in full effect commencing from the date of the violation (March 4, 2018).
