

On March 22, 2018, the Committee for Initiation of City Ordinance submitted two documents to the City Auditor's office for review. The undersigned City Auditor responds as follows to your request for approval.

According to the Home Rule Charter of the City of Valley City, Barnes County, North Dakota,

A petition to initiate an ordinance shall be presented to the City Auditor for approval as to form prior to circulation. Each petition shall have printed thereon: "Initiation of city ordinance providing for ______" and shall accurately identify and summarize the true nature of the initiated ordinance and set forth the text of the ordinance. A request for approval shall be presented over the names and signature of three (3) or more qualified electors who shall constitute the 'Committee for the Petitioners' and who shall act for the petitioners. Within ten (10) days after receipt of the petition, the City Auditor shall either approve the petition for circulation if it is in proper form and contains the full text of the measure or if the City Auditor does not approve the petition, he or she shall give written notice to the Committee for the petitioners of his or her reason for not approving their petition.

... The petition shall be filed in the City Auditor's office and shall contain a request that the ordinance set out in the petition be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the City if it is not passed by the governing body of the municipality.

The purpose of the review by the City Auditor is to ensure that petitions are worded clearly and simply so the petition is not misleading or likely to cause confusion to voters. Petition drafts must be consistent with applicable law. If the Auditor does not approve the petition for circulation, it may be redrafted and resubmitted

After consulting with the City Attorney, I must reject your application for the following reasons:

1. The Home Rule Charter requires your petition to contain a request "that the ordinance set out in the petition be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the City if it is not

- passed by the governing body of the municipality." However, your petition does not contain this required language.
- 2. More importantly, your document does not set forth the text of the ordinance. In fact, there is not even a section identified as the "initiated ordinance."
- 3. Additionally, the Auditor must reject your request because it is unclear what the electorate would be voting on. The Home Rule Charter requires your petition to "accurately identify and summarize the true nature of the initiated ordinance" The second document the Committee submitted is entitled "PETITION TO INITIATE AN ORDINANCE CITY OF VALLEY CITY, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA." The document states, "The purpose of this petition is the initiation of city ordinance providing that funding and approval of Valley City Project number SU-2-990 (057), Central Avenue-Urban Grant Project be first approved by a majority of the qualified electors prior to funding and approving said project." If the electorate were to vote on the language provided by your Committee they would essentially be voting on whether or not they will be voting on the Streetscape Project.
- 4. The ordinance is also unclear because it provides that the vote take place before the funding and approval of the project. However, "funding and approval" is ambiguous.
- 5. In your instruction to the petition signers, you state, "This means you are eighteen years old, you have lived in the city of Valley City, North Dakota thirty days, and you are a United States citizen." However, you have not properly defined "qualified electors."
- 6. Home Rule charter requires that, "[e]ach petition shall have printed thereon: 'Initiation of city ordinance providing for ______'," however, your petition says "initiation of an ordinance providing that." (emphasis added). This error in form is negligible, but is being pointed out if you choose to redraft your ordinance.

Again, in consultation with the City Attorney, I find that the submitted petition does not conform to the appropriate form and does not contain the full text of the measure. These issues could possibly be corrected with an appropriate redraft of the submitted petition, however, this office cannot provide you with specific legal advice about how to correct these deficiencies. You may wish to consult with an attorney in preparing a redraft of the petition.






