All articles must be exhibited by the maker or grower. Articles must not have been exhibited previously at any fair. Worn, soiled or unfinished articles shall not be exhibited.

Entries to be judged will be accepted by the Exhibit Committee between 3 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. on Friday, September 7. No entries will be accepted on Saturday.

Exhibits shall not be removed without the consent of the committee. Exhibits cannot be removed until 3 p.m. and must be removed by 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 8.

The committee will not be responsible for breakage or loss of any articles.
