

Human Service Redesign Explained


NEXT STEPS

NDACo and the Department of Human Services are planning a statewide meeting of all counties, involving all county social service directors and up to two individuals from each county. The goal is to have a good mix of commissioners, social service board member and county auditors (particularly auditors from the likely "host" counties) to participate in a presentation and discussion about the details of the bill, timelines, finances, decision-making processes, etc. The meeting is planned for **June 11, 2019 at the State Capitol.** This will be followed with technical assistance with templates for zone agreements, zone plans, and consultation as questions arise.
