Proclamation

BURN BAN

BARNES COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA

March 26th, 2021

WHEREAS, Barnes County, North Dakota is under abnormally dry Conditions;

WHEREAS the impact of fires could threaten the health, well-being, and safety of citizens in Barnes County; and

WHEREAS the cost of response and the inordinate equipment wear may be far in excess of available county resources.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that after discussion with each individual County Commissioner it was decided that the current Burn Ban for Barnes County, North Dakota will remain in effect until April 7th, 2021 at which time the burn ban will be reviewed. It should be noted that Commissioner Lovell was against extending the burn ban and wanted to allow the burn ban to expire.

This burn ban prohibits the burning of leaves, grass clippings, garbage/pits, construction debris, fallen trees, crop residue or hay land, sloughs, and campfires/bonfires. *Residents can use their grills and fire pits so long as there is an adult present and monitoring the said items and the adult ensures the fire pit and/or grill are completely extinguished when done using them.*

ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO WILLFULLY VIOLATES THIS BURN BAN IS GUILTY OF A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR, WHICH CARRIES A PENALTY OF UP TO THIRTY (30) DAYS IN JAIL AND A \$1,500.00 FINE PER INCIDENT, AS WELL AS THE COST FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION.
