
BARNES COUNTY COVID-19 RESPONSE REPORT SEPTEMBER 15, 2021

VACCINATION

City-County Health District is currently vaccinating all individuals ages 12 and over. We have moved into the administration of additional doses for individuals who are immunocompromised. We are awaiting guidance from the North Dakota State Department of Health to begin administering booster doses to the general public. Our goal is to reach **community immunity**, which requires that we achieve a **vaccinate rate over 70%** in Barnes County.

TESTING



CASE INVESTIGATION & CONTACT TRACING
