The Barnes County State's Attorney charges:

- [¶1] <u>Count 1</u>: That on or about January 19, 2022, in Barnes County, North Dakota, the defendant, Justin Neal Gibson, did commit the offense of **Child Abuse**, in violation of North Dakota Century Code section 14-09-22(1), 12.1-32-01(2), by then and there: The defendant, a parent, adult family or household member, guardian, or other custodian of any child, willfully inflicted or allowed to be inflicted upon a child, mental injury or bodily injury, substantial bodily injury, or serious bodily injury, and the child was under the age of six (6) and suffered a permanent loss or impairment of the function of a bodily member or organ, in particular: Defendant, a parent to H.G., willfully inflicted serious bodily injury upon H.G., a child under the age of 6, and H.G. suffered permanent loss or impairment of the function of a bodily member or organ. This offense is a **Class A Felony.**
- [¶2] <u>Count 2</u>: That on or about January 19, 2022, in Barnes County, North Dakota, the defendant, Justin Neal Gibson, did commit the offense of **Aggravated Assault-Domestic violence**, in violation of North Dakota Century Code section 12.1-17-02(1)(c), 14-07.1-01, 12.1-17-02(2)(a), 12.1-17-13, 12.1-32-01(3), by then and there: The defendant caused bodily injury or substantial bodily injury to a family or household member, that person being under twelve (12) years of age, while attempting to inflict serious bodily injury on any human being, in particular: Defendant caused bodily injury or serious bodily injury to H.G., a family or household member, who is under the age of 12, while attempting to inflict serious bodily injury on H.G. This offense is a **Class B Felony.**
- [¶3] <u>Count 3</u>: That on or about January 2, 2022, in Barnes County, North Dakota, the defendant, Justin Neal Gibson, did commit the offense of **Child Abuse**, in violation of North Dakota Century Code section 14-09-22(1), 12.1-32-01(3), by then and there: The defendant, a parent, adult family or household member, guardian, or other custodian of any child, willfully inflicted or allowed to be inflicted upon a child, mental injury or bodily injury, substantial bodily injury, or serious bodily injury, and the child was under the age of six (6), in particular: Defendant, a parent to H.G., willfully inflicted bodily injury upon H.G., a child under the age of 6. This offense is a **Class B Felony.**
- [¶4] <u>Count 4</u>: That on or about a time between November 28, 2021 and December 4, 2021, in Barnes County, North Dakota, the defendant, Justin Neal Gibson, did commit the offense of **Child Abuse**, in violation of North Dakota Century Code section 14-09-22(1), 12.1-32-01(3), by then and there: The defendant, a parent, adult family or household member, guardian, or other custodian of any child, willfully inflicted or allowed to be inflicted upon a child, mental injury or bodily injury, substantial bodily injury, or serious bodily injury, and the child was under the age of six (6), in particular: Defendant, a parent to H.G., willfully inflicted bodily injury upon H.G., a child under the age of 6. This offense is a **Class B Felony.**
