All kindergarten students or students entering the Knoxville Schools for the first time <u>MUST present their birth certificate and immunization verification</u> at the time of registration. Pupils entering from other schools must show evidence of the grade completed at time of registration.

### Family Rights and Privacy Act

<u>Directory Information</u>: In compliance with the "Family Rights and Privacy Act of 1974" parents and students should be aware that the following information may be released in regard to any individual student of the Knoxville Community School District as necessary or desirability arises: Name, address, telephone listing, date and place of birth, major field of study, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, date of attendance, degrees and awards received, and the most recent previous school or institution attended by the student.
