Thursday, July 23rd---Sheep and Goat Auction-- Sale begins at 5:30 PM

No re-weigh for sheep/goats before sale-will use morning weight

Sell in large show ring

Monday, July 27th---Chickens, Swine, Cattle Auction-- Sale begins at 8 AM

Animals will be present

Broiler/Roaster Chicken Pen of Three sell first in small animal ring

Exhibitors with Pen of Three Broiler/Roaster --- be on the grounds by 7 AM Monday for the auction

Buyers may purchase for their own use and pick up dressed birds at 5 PM Monday at the fairgrounds.

Buyers may purchase birds to be donated to the Indianola Food Pantry after being dressed.

Swine sells second in the small animal ring

Exhibitors may sell up to 2 hogs only

All swine must go to a Locker. There is no packer/buyer.

Cattle sells third in the large animal ring

Re-weigh of cattle will begin at 6:30 AM Monday AM for auction.

Cattle tie outs will not be used on Saturday or Sunday night. Must stay in Barn #1 overnight.

Market Beef will stay on the grounds Saturday/Sunday night for auction on Monday.

Take feed and water away from market animals at 10 PM until after weighing in on Monday AM.

Barn will be locked at 9 PM each night and opened at 5 AM each morning.
