COVID-19 Winter Activities: Capacity Restrictions Plan

- Per Governor Reynolds' proclamation on November 10, 2020, the following is in effect from 1201 AM November 11, 2020, until 1159 PM November 30, 2020, at extracurricular events at Knoxville Community Schools:
 - Each student that is performing in an extracurricular event shall receive a maximum of two tickets for spectators to attend the event.
 - If a student is performing in the event - they receive 2 tickets. (example: a high school basketball game. Players in uniform for the game receive 2 tickets as do cheerleaders in uniform).
 - If a student is performing in an event where there are other levels of competition occurring, the spectators with a ticket are able to stay and watch the other levels of competition. (example: a high school basketball game with JV2, JV1, and Varsity levels. The ticket-holder can watch all levels play).
 - Spectator admission into a KCS D extracurricular event will be done as following:
 - Students who will be performing in the event will designate who they want to receive their two tickets on a Pass List.
 - This Pass List will be shared with our coaches/sponsors and our opponents well in advance of the date of the event.
 - The Pass List will then be at the ticket gate and spectators will check-in with the ticket-taker at the ticket gate.
 - People not on the Pass List will not be permitted into the facility to watch the event.
 - Children under the age of 2 do not need a ticket.
 - People working the event will not be granted tickets for spectators.
 - There will be a list at the gate of all workers working that event. Workers need to enter the facility at the main entrance and check-in with the ticket-taker at the gate.
 - Opposing schools who have workers working the event will be on this worker list (example: a parent keeping the scorebook at the scoretable).
 - Coaches/Sponsors and managers will not receive tickets for spectators.
 - KCS D staff members can only attend events if they are on the Pass List.
 - Concession stands will be in operation as they normally would at our extracurricular events.
 - Members of the media may have to show credentials upon request to gain admittance to the event.
 - In the event the Governor extends this capacity restrictions proclamation, this plan will extend to the ending date of the proclamation as well.
 - Per Knoxville's original COVID activities plan (and reinforced in Governor Reynolds' proclamation), masks are required for all spectators at all Knoxville Community School District events.
