Join Dave Baker, founder of “The 29th State”. He is a storyteller, hotoographer, essayist and researcher who documents and celebrates Iowa history and heritage. He has photographed over 10,000 sites, landmarks and points of interest around Iowa, visiting nearly all 99 counties and covering 1,200 towns and former village sites - better known as ghost towns.
