Emergency Management Plan

COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN FOR GREENE COUNTY, IOWA

I. Purpose

The purpose of this multi-hazard plan is to develop a procedure for warning RAGBRAI participants and local citizens of approaching severe weather *or other danger*, and to identify locations of safety where RAGBRAI participants may seek shelter and protection. Severe weather is the most likely event and will be stressed.

II. Policy

The GREENE County Emergency Management Agency, in cooperation with the Greene County Sheriff's Office, the National Weather Service, the Jefferson Police Department and Department of Public Safety, will monitor weather conditions during the time RAGBRAI will be riding in and staying overnight in Jefferson, Iowa. The Greene County Law Enforcement Center will make appropriate notifications of weather watches and warnings *and any other dangerous situations* if such conditions occur. **If a critical incident should occur, a public information officer will be appointed by the sheriff or his designee and all information pertaining to that event will be provided by that officer. The PIO's name and contact number will be provided by the Greene County Law Enforcement Center at 515-386-2136.**

III. Definitions

A *watch* means that conditions are favorable for the formation of severe weather in a designated area. Preparations should be made to protect yourself and the persons around you.

A *warning* means that a severe thunderstorm or a tornado has been spotted in the area. Immediate evacuation to a place of safety is necessary.

IV. Procedure

1. The National Weather Service and the Greene County Sheriff's Office and Jefferson Police Department will advise all personnel in the field of approaching severe weather in a timely manner.
2. Upon notification of approaching severe weather the Greene County Law Enforcement Center will broadcast all watches and warnings to Greene County Emergency Management, local fire departments and law enforcement agencies. Emergency shelters will then be unlocked and manned upon such notification.
3. If a severe thunderstorm warning or tornado warning is issued for Greene County, all Law Enforcement Agencies and RAGBRAI officials will be notified by a broadcast from the Greene County Law Enforcement Center. Law Enforcement officers will announce the warning to all RAGBRAI participants with the public address systems. Riders will be notified to relocate to the nearest emergency shelter. If the National Weather Service has issued a tornado warning, the outdoor warning sirens shall be activated by the Greene County Law Enforcement and sounded.
4. A listing of all shelters assigned for all RAGBRAI participants concerning a thunderstorm or tornado in Jefferson is designated on the attached map.
5. *If any other dangerous situation develops such as a hazardous materials spill, biohazard threat or any other dangerous situation affecting riders or residents during the RAGBRAI event the Iowa Department of Public Safety will be informed of the nature of the emergency and all local law-enforcement and emergency personnel will be instructed as to the appropriate action.*

General Information

Should severe weather threaten or strike Jefferson or Greene County during RAGBRAI's stay, the following procedures will be used:

Notification and Preparation:

The Des Moines office of the National Weather Service issues storm watches and warnings for Jefferson and Greene County. The Greene County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) has notified the Des Moines office of the RAGBRAI event-taking place in Jefferson and Greene County July 23-24, 2018. The National Weather Service has agreed to give the Greene County EMA early notification of impending severe weather. Once early notification is received, local law enforcement, fire, EMS and other first responders will receive a notification page from the Greene County Dispatch Center. Watches and warnings will be broadcast over local commercial radio broadcast from Perry, Iowa (KDLS 1310 A.M) and Jefferson, Iowa (KGRA 98.9 F.M.). The fairgrounds public address system will broadcast this information along with law enforcement public address systems in patrol vehicles.

Outdoor Warning System

In the event that severe weather is approaching the city of Jefferson or Greene County, the following procedures will be used to warn the local population and RAGBRAI participants. For early warnings, the Greene County Law Enforcement shall call for the sirens to be sounded.

Severe Thunderstorm Warning:

1. Law enforcement, fire departments, volunteer workers and emergency medical personnel may use vehicle/handheld loudspeakers to notify bikers and campers in the designated camping areas. The campgrounds in Jefferson will also be warned by loudspeakers and/or by sirens. Each town in Greene County has sirens and they can be activated collectively or selectively.
2. Public address systems in the campgrounds will be separated out by areas and instructions given to each group individually as to their designated shelter areas and other individualized instructions.
3. All persons must move to the designated safe areas immediately.
4. *See shelter locations map that is attached.*
5. *See attached phone list.*

Tornado Warning:

1. The outdoor warning sirens in Jefferson will be sounded for three minutes.
2. Public address systems in the campgrounds will be separated out by areas and instructions given to each group individually as to their designated shelter areas and other individualized instructions. Groups outside the campgrounds will also be notified by public address systems.
3. All persons must move to shelters immediately.
4. All persons must remain in designated shelters until receiving official notification that it is safe to leave the shelters.
5. The RAGBRAI Communications Committee will assist affected persons in taking or making emergency calls.
6. A communications and status board will be placed on the Greene County Community Center information area.
7. The all-clear signal will be broadcast on KDLS (1310 AM) and KGRA (98.9) and vehicle loudspeakers in all camping areas.
8. *See shelter and shuttle bus list attachment.*
9. *See attached phone list.*

Assistance

Assistance in emergency situations will be handled by the following:

1. Law Enforcement personnel with radios, sirens and loud speakers.
2. Fire Department personnel and vehicles with radios, sirens and loud speakers.
3. Greene County Emergency Management Personnel using radio equipment and the public address hand held system.
4. Greene County Emergency Medical Services personnel using radios, sirens, and loud speakers.
5. Jefferson RAGBRAI Communications Committee personnel using radio equipment.
6. Jefferson RAGBRAI Campground Committee personnel using radio equipment.
7. Jefferson RAGBRAI Hospitality Committee personnel using radio equipment.
8. Jefferson RAGBRAI Transportation Committee personnel using radio equipment.

Storm spotters will be used from the local storm-spotter network including trained storm-spotting individuals, fire departments and law enforcement agencies. Safety and evacuation procedures as well as maps will be posted at campsites and information centers.

Should a specific emergency occur, the Jefferson city RAGBRAI public information officer (PIO) will be designated.

Downtown Storm/Tornado Shelter Assignments (BEVERAGE AREA):

The regular storm shelter locations of businesses on main street will be utilized during their regular business hours on the days that RAGBRAI is in Jefferson city. In the event that these locations are closed during an emergency, the shuttle busses will be used to transport to other locations, time permitting. These shuttle buses will transport people to schools/churches in the local area.

Dialing 515-386-2136 reaches the main switchboard at the Law Enforcement Center in Jefferson, which will be staffed at all times. This number will be called and instructed to activate the calling tree for the emergency shelter plan.

Evacuation Procedure

All persons staying will take shelter in the buildings/homes designated on the map and by signs posted on homes and yards. All persons who are downtown will take shelter in the locations previously designated in this plan, which will be indicated by a **tornado shelter sign** placed on the building front. Additionally, signs will be placed on lawns of homes and in their windows that can be used during severe/tornado conditions. Listed below are the official campgrounds for the RAGBRAI event:

Shuttle Bus Procedure

Upon notification to the transportation director, all busses will discontinue regular routes and will begin implementing emergency routes. If the emergency occurs while the downtown locations are unavailable (i.e.: after 5 pm), the shuttle busses will be used to transport people to the above designated shelters

Buses will pick people up from the downtown area at the following locations:

1. Greene County Middle School

If severe weather is expected within two hours of the shuttle bus closing, the bus drivers will be held on notice around main street (Beverage area) and at the designated campground areas. If severe weather strikes after the drivers have gone home, the transportation director will be contacted and the bus drivers will be recalled. The campers will be notified to immediately proceed to the designated shelters that are around them by public loud speakers.

Additional Information

Emergency Management and the Greene County Law Enforcement will maintain close contact with the National Weather Service by telephone, amateur radio voice links and state teletype. We will monitor our National Weather and radar screen for the duration of this event in our county. Should the need arise for evacuation, Law Enforcement, Fire, and Emergency Management will consult and the Incident Commander (law enforcement) will make the final decision.

All first responding agencies will maintain close radio/voice contact during RAGBRAI. Our primary concern is the safety of our residents and guests during this event. ***If there are any questions or omitted items, the Greene County Multi-Hazard Plan will be implemented.***

Safety Tips

Before Lightning Strikes...

- Keep an eye on the sky. Look for darkening skies, flashes of light, or increasing wind. Listen for the sound of thunder.
- If you can hear thunder, you are close enough to the storm to be struck by lightning. Go to safe shelter immediately.
- Listen to NOAA Weather Radio, commercial radio, television or Campground Public Address System/Loud speaker system for the latest weather forecasts.

When a Storm Approaches...

- Find shelter in a building or depression. Cover head with hands and roll up into a ball.
- Telephone lines and metal pipes can conduct electricity. Unplug appliances. Avoid using the telephone or any electrical appliances. (Leaving electric lights on, however, does not increase the chances of your home being struck by lightning.)
- Avoid taking a bath or shower, or running water for any other purpose.
- Turn off the air conditioner. Power surges from lightning can overload the compressor, resulting in a costly repair job!
- Draw blinds and shades over windows. If windows break due to objects blown by the wind, the shades will prevent glass from shattering into your home.

If Caught Outside...

- If you are on the road between towns, take shelter under the shorter trees. If there are no trees under, take shelter in the ditch or a depression.
- If you are boating or swimming, get to land and find shelter immediately!

Protecting Yourself Outside...

- Go to a low-lying, open place away from trees, poles, or metal objects. Make sure the place you pick is not subject to flooding.
- Be a very small target! Squat low to the ground. Place your hands on your knees with your head between them. Make yourself the smallest target possible.
- Do not lie flat on the ground--this will make you a larger target!

After the Storm Passes...

- Stay away from downed power lines.
- Listen to the radio for information and instructions.
- Listen to the Campground Public Address Systems.

Stay Tuned for Storm Warnings

- Listen to your local radio, TV stations and Campground Public Address Systems for updated storm information.
- Know what a tornado WATCH and WARNING means:
 - A tornado WATCH means a tornado is possible in your area.
 - A tornado WARNING means a tornado has been sighted and may be headed for your area. Go to safety immediately.
- Tornado WATCHES and WARNINGS are issued by the National Weather Service.

When a Tornado WATCH Is Issued...

- Listen to local radio, TV stations and Campground Public Address Systems for further updates.
- Be alert to changing weather conditions. Blowing debris or the sound of an approaching tornado may alert you. Many people say it sounds like a freight train.

When a Tornado WARNING Is Issued...

- If you are inside, go to an interior room to protect yourself from glass and other flying objects. The tornado may be approaching your area.
- If you are outside in a campground, hurry to the basement of a nearby sturdy building/home or lie flat in a ditch or low-lying area.
- If you are in a car or mobile home, get out immediately and head for safety (as above).

After the Tornado Passes...

- Watch out for fallen power lines and stay out of the damaged area.
- Listen to the radio and Campground Public Address System for information and instructions.
- Use a flashlight to inspect your situation for damage.

SAG Wagon Unload

The RAGBRAI SAG wagon drop off will be at the teachers parking lot at the Greene County High School, near the corner of HWY 4 (Elm St) and Ram Dr. It will be a 15 passenger van that patrols the route until 6:00pm picking up riders and dropping them off. There is no charge for the service. Riders are asked to turn the bicycle upside down (wheels up) on the left side of the road and motion with a “thumbs down” signal.

RAGBRAI Beverage Garden & Main Stage Area entrances are located around the square on State St (northwest side of square by Uptown Café), Wilson Ave, and Chestnut St. The main stage is located on the northeast corner of the square between Ace Hardware and Meythaler Photography, and there will NOT be a public entrance there.

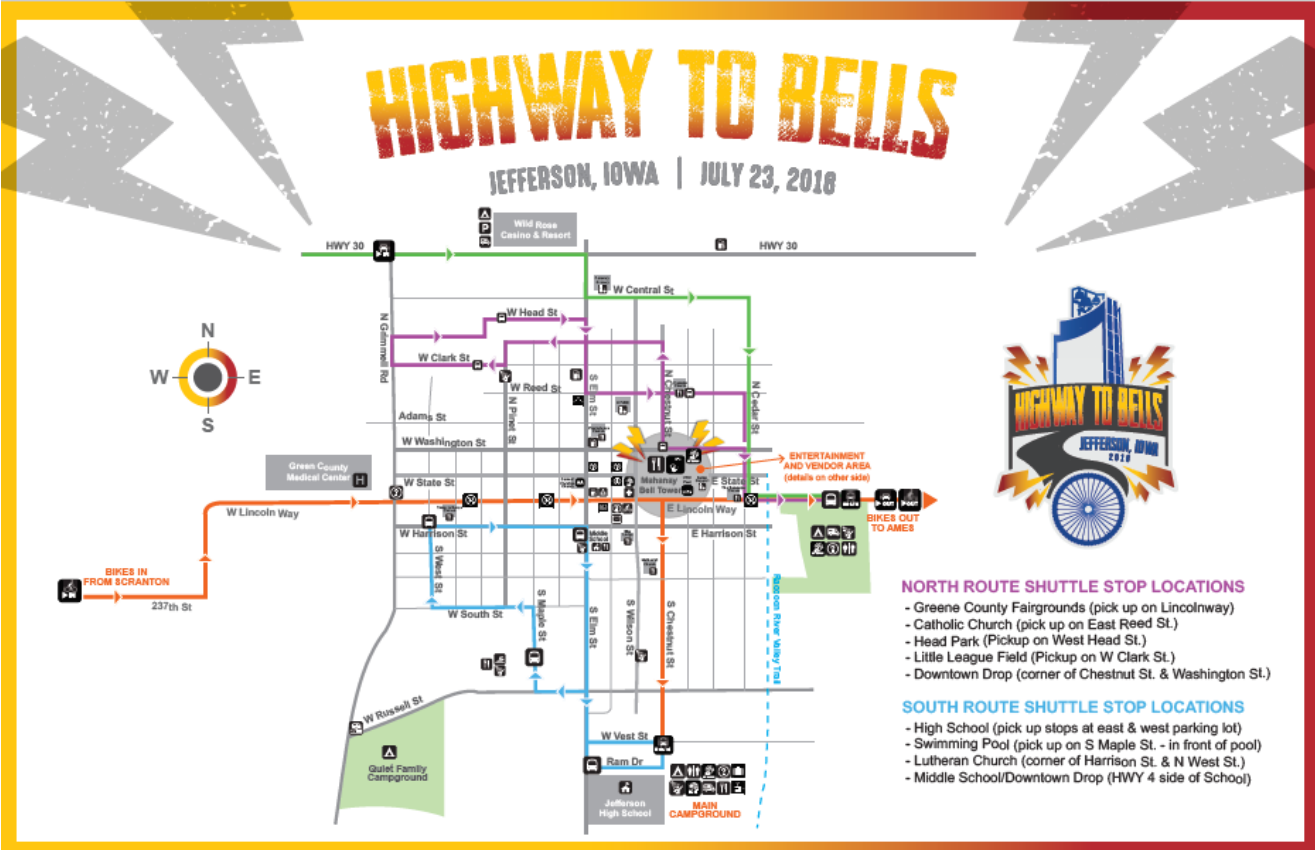
Showers
