On 08/04/19 at approximately 1125 hrs I was dispatched to a two-vehicle property damage accident in the Hy-Vee parking lot, located at 1215 141st St. Upon arriving a short time later, I observed Unit two on the west side of the isle facing northwest and unit one on the east side of the isle facing northeast. The right rear bumper of unit two was touching the left rear quarter panel of unit one. The driver of unit two was still sitting in her vehicle and the driver of unit one was standing next to his vehicle. As I got out to approach the drivers, a female, identified as Lisa Hise, advised that she had witnessed the collision. She stated that she was walking southbound in the isle toward the store and observed that unit two had back out of the parking stall and had stopped. Prior to driving forward, unit one began to back out. She said the driver of unit two honked her horn a couple of times, but the driver of unit one didn't stop and struck unit two in the right rear bumper. The driver of unit two advised the same as the witness. The driver of unit one stated that he was backing out and didn't see unit two and then they collided. Unit one sustained minor damage to the right rear bumper. The damage was estimated at \$500.00. Unit one sustained damage to the left rear bumper and quarter panel. The damage was estimated at \$900.00. There were no injuries reported. The scene and vehicles were photographed. No citations were issued due to the collision occurring on private property.
