RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF STREETS DURING RAGBRAI 2018

This Resolution is Established Pursuant to the City of Sigourney Ordinance Number 3-6B-15

WHEREAS, the Sigourney City Council has received a request from the Sigourney RAGBRAI Committee to close various streets during the upcoming RAGBRAI event, beginning on Thursday, July 26th, 2018 and concluding Friday, July 27th, 2018, and

WHEREAS, for the safety of the citizens of Sigourney and guests for the 2018 RAGBRAI, and

WHEREAS, during the effective dates and times of this resolution the following streets will be closed (including alleys located in these blocks) and no motor vehicle will be allowed to operate or park in them except as authorized by the official Sigourney RAGBRAI Executive Committee and the Sigourney Police Department and any unauthorized parked vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense upon the request of the Sigourney Police Department:

BICYCLE ROUTE – Wednesday, July 25th at 6:00 p.m. to Friday, July 27th at 12:00 p.m. (Noon):

Kramer Street between County Road V-45 and North Cherry Street
North Cherry Street between Kramer and Clark Street
Clark Street between North Cherry Street and North Main Street
North Main Street between Clark and Jackson Street
East South Street between South Main Street and Russell Street
Russell Street between East South Street and East Pleasant Valley Street
East Pleasant Valley Street between Russell and to the East Corporate Limits
220th Avenue between 225th Street and to the North Corporate Limits, and

BEVERAGE GARDEN, VENDOR & SUPPORT STAFF AREAS – Wed., July 25th at 6:00 p.m. to Fri., July 27th at 12:00 p.m. (Noon):

East Elm Street between North Main Street and North Shuffleton Street
East Washington Street between Main Street and Shuffleton Street
West Washington Street between Main Street and the East Side of the Alley in the 100 Block of West Washington Street
East Marion Street between South Main Street and South Shuffleton Street
West Marion Street between South Main Street and South Stuart Street
Jefferson Street between East Walnut Street and East Spring Street

ALLEYS – Wednesday, July 25th at 6:00 p.m. to Friday, July 27th at 12:00 p.m. (Noon):

East-West Alley between the 200 Block of South Stuart Street and the 200 Block of South Jefferson Street
North-South Alley between the 200 Block of East Elm Street and the 200 Block of East Marion Street
East-West Alley between the 100 Block of North Shuffleton Street and 100 Block of North Main Street
East-West Alley between the 100 Block of South Jefferson Street and the 100 Block of South Shuffleton Street
North-South Alley between the 100 Block of East Washington Street and the 100 Block of East Elm Street
North-South Alley between the 100 Block of East Marion Street and the 100 Block of East Spring Street
North-South Alley between the 100 Block of 100 West Marion Street and the 100 Block of West Spring Street


WHEREAS, due to the safety concerns of the citizens of Sigourney and the bicyclists participating in the RAGBRAI event, the Iowa Department of Transportation has authorized a detour around the City of Sigourney on Highway 149 during the effective dates and times of this resolution and the following street will be closed and no motor vehicle will be allowed to operate or park on Main Street between Jackson Street and Pleasant Valley Street from Thursday, July 26th at 6:00 a.m. to Friday, July 27th at 6:00 a.m., and there will be no parking on Main Street between Jackson Street and Pleasant Valley Street from Wednesday, July 25th at 6:00 p.m. to Friday, July 27th at 12:00 p.m. (Noon), except as authorized by the official Sigourney RAGBRAI Executive Committee and the Sigourney Police Department and any unauthorized parked vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense upon the request of the Sigourney Police Department.

WHEREAS, during the effective dates of this resolution and without prior Council approval regarding the blocking of any additional streets, City of Sigourney police officers, or those at their direction, may place barricades or road blocks in the city street, alley or roadway to redirect vehicular traffic in order to enhance the proper and safe flow of bicycle and vehicular traffic within the City of Sigourney, Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIGOURNEY, IOWA; the aforementioned streets be temporarily closed as requested and indicated above on Wednesday, July 25th, Thursday, July 26th and Friday, July 27th, and the RAGBRAI Committee members will notify each resident along the bike route with a copy of this resolution.
