

2017 Shopping Cart Showdown-The Race

Official Rules

- Participating businesses/organizations will designate a representative to participate in the race.
- Each business will be assigned a Blazer Super Shopper to shop alongside them. The Super Shopper must also abide by the following rules
- Each representative will be required to sign a Waiver, Release and Hold Harmless Agreement prior to participating in the race to officially become a contestant.
- All contestants will start at the designated start/finish line.
- There will be one official clock kept by a station representative (timekeeper).
- Only the official time as reported/monitored by the timekeeper will be acknowledged for the duration of the race. The timekeeper's decisions are final.
- Each subsequent contestant will then start when cued by the timekeeper.
- The maximum shopping time for any participating business/organization will be 91 seconds (1:31).
- The contestants are allowed one cart for the contest and may utilize all space available.
- Only non-perishables will be added to the contestant's check-out total.
- Contestants may not carry any items to the front, everything must fit in or on the cart.
- When the time has expired, the host will announce STOP and all contestants must proceed to the front of the store. A station representative will help escort the cart to a check-out (register).
- All groceries will be totaled and the contestant with the 'highest total value' will be declared the winner. All non-perishable items collected by each contestant will be awarded to the participating businesses for their selected charity.
- The overall winner as determined by the check-out totals will be declared the Shopping Cart Showdown Champion and awarded the Shopping Cart Showdown trophy to put on display at their business or the charity's office location.
- In the case of a tie of the actual dollar amount, the team with the most items will be deemed the winner.
