

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE AUTHORITY TO THE TOWN OF CHURCH POINT TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE FY2027 COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Church Point intends to apply for funding for sewer system improvements under the FY2027 Community Project Funding program; and

**WHEREAS**, the program requires the signature of a sewer system official on various documents; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Church Point, that Mayor Ryan “Spanky” Meche is hereby authorized to sign and submit all of the necessary applications, agreements, reports, studies, plans, contracts, permits, Contractor Invoices, Engineering Invoices, and any other documents required in connection with the Water System Improvements Project under the FY2027 Community Project Funding.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town of Church Point commits to the required match of the grant using local funds if the application for sewer system improvements is funded;


