Please keep this information in mind when booking and visiting remote broadcasts and events with McKibbin Media Group.

- McKibbin Media Group will adhere to any Executive Orders in place by the local and state officials regarding the COVID-19 Pandemic at the time of our event, especially as they relate to social distancing and sanitary measures.
- These guidelines may change as things evolve; please visit WKHM.com for the latest Remote Broadcast Guidelines.
- Radio staff may wear face coverings where appropriately indicated by the CDC; except while talking into a microphone.
- Guests/interviewees will be given a separate microphone and remain opposite the DJ/Show host across our 6-foot table.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available to use as needed.
- Microphones will be sanitized between users.
- Visitors must stay 6-10 feet away from our broadcast table/tent area which may be roped off.
- Prize entry: physical prize entry materials may be available with proper social distancing measures in place. As a safe alternative, we may direct users to a website where they can enter using their own mobile device for a chance to win a prize.
