# EMEC to Sponsor Two Students for June '23 Event in US Capital

Eastern Maine Electric wants to send two area high school students to Washington, D.C. next June, as part of the 2023 Electric Co-op Youth Tour. Participants will explore monuments and museums, meet their legislators, and learn about the political process. They also build friendships that can last a lifetime.

For the local students, there will be no cost for travel expenses, meals, lodging, admission or other tour-related costs. Applications are open online at www.emec.com/YouthTour.

Each year, more than 1,500 students from around the country are sponsored by their electric cooperatives to take part in the Tour. Since its inception nearly six decades ago, the Electric Co-op Youth Tour has brought history alive for over 50,000 alumni.

For the 2023 Youth Tour, Eastern Maine Electric is partnering with the Association of Louisiana Electric Cooperatives. The Louisiana-Maine group will total 22 students. This arrangement will make the trip more

cost-effective for Maine and for all the Louisiana Cooperatives. More importantly, it allows each co-op to provide the best experience possible for its sponsored students.



Maine's representatives to the Youth Tour will be selected based on their applications and interviews. Applicants should be high school sophomores or juniors who are bona fide residents of a home served by Eastern Maine Electric. The children and grandchildren of EMEC employees and board members are not eligible.

The deadline for submitting Youth Tour applications is February 28, 2023. In early March, applicants will be interviewed, and the 2023 Maine winners will be announced by April 1st.
