- The proposed 2026 budget that is being worked on by the Budget Advisory Committee, has an increase of 39.87%. This includes the first payment of the bond if it were to pass. Only the County tax portion of your tax bill would increase by 39.87%. Approximately 10% of the 39.87% is a payment for the bond.
