Participation in job fair by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions	10/17/2018: Our SEU’s Leadership Team Member/Director of Promotions and Marketing as well as our Promotions Assistant participated in the UT Communications and Internship Job Fair on the campus of the University of Tennessee. They occupied a display table and talked with interested students/attendees about career opportunities in broadcasting, the SEU’s internship program and the education/skill sets necessary to be successful in this industry.
Establishment of a mentoring program for station personnel	September–December 2018: Our WKHT-FM Program Director developed a mentoring program designed to teach our Promotions Assistant the skills necessary to become an on-air personality after he/she expressed an interest in this position. They met for training sessions three-to-four times a month, during which all aspects of this position were discussed in depth. The training also required the Promotions Assistant to “job shadow” the WKHT on-air staff. As a result, our Promotions Assistant is now handling some live and voice-tracked shifts after midnight.
