Outreach Programs this timeframe includes:

August 20th, 2024: WAKG and WBTM attended Averett University's "Cougar Business Fest." This event was held to welcome Averett University students back to the area and educate them on businesses and their resources available to them. We had employees stationed at a booth informing students about our two radio stations, giving them a chance to win and informing students who are seeking journalism opportunities on how to get started in radio broadcasting.

October 24th, 2024: WAKG and WBTM attended and broadcast live from Reidsville Chamber of Commerce's Job and Resource Fair, from 3pm – 6pm.
