For example: If you originally had tickets to the opening night show of Matilda on March 27, your tickets will be transferred to the exact seats on the newly scheduled opening night on May 8.

If you have purchased a ticket to one of these events, your ticket will be held in reservation until April 14. At that time, you will be emailed your new tickets. If this new date does not work for you, please contact the Springfield Little Theatre Box Office to exchange your tickets for a new date.
