## NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE (CARBON COUNTY MUNICIPAL SERVICES FUND)

Carbon County is proposing to increase its property tax revenue. The Carbon County Municipal Services Tax on a \$150,000 residence would increase from \$25.99 to \$216.48, which is \$190.49 per year.

The Municipal Services tax on a \$150,000 business would increase from \$47.25 to \$393.59, which is \$346.34 per year.

If the proposed budget is approved, Carbon County would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 32.47% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase, at which the County Commission will explain the reasons for the proposed increase and at which the public may provide comments to the County Commission regarding the proposed tax increase. The public hearing will be held in conjunction with the public hearing on the 2020 Carbon County budget.
