

## **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

**February 25, 2026** — A high-risk domestic disturbance on Wellington Main Street concluded safely in the early morning hours after a multi-hour standoff required the deployment of the Carbon County SWAT team. One male suspect is in custody following the incident.

### **Incident Summary**

Law Enforcement originally responded to a residence on Wellington Main Street regarding a domestic violence call. Upon arrival, law enforcement attempted to make contact with the male subject involved. The subject refused to cooperate with lawful commands and barricaded himself inside the residence, refusing to exit.

To ensure the safety of all involved and the surrounding neighborhood, Main Street was temporarily closed to all vehicle and pedestrian traffic while the situation was managed.

### **Tactical Intervention and Arrest**

Due to the presence of a barricaded subject and the violent nature of the call, a warrant was drafted by law enforcement, reviewed, and approved by a judge. The Carbon County SWAT Team was activated to assist.

After continued negotiations, the SWAT team successfully convinced the suspect to exit the residence. He was taken into custody without further injury to the public or law enforcement. Main Street was reopened to traffic shortly thereafter.

### **Charges and Booking**

The suspect was transported and booked into the Carbon County Jail.
