


Saturday's Severe Weather Outlook

October 16, 2025 4:16 AM CDT

Low end severe risk across the region with the slightly higher risk in southeast Missouri.

Two Rounds of Storms Possible Saturday

Round 1: Saturday afternoon. Round 2: Saturday evening into Sunday morning.

Potential Round #1 of Storms:

- Location: Southeast MO and Southwest IL
- Timing: Saturday Afternoon
- Hazards: Low end tornado, wind, and hail threats.

Potential Round #2 of Storms:

- Location: Entire region, from northwest to southeast.
- Timing: Saturday Night into Early Sunday Morning.
- Hazards: Low end tornado and wind threats.
