Native Broadcast Enterprise in St. Michaels, Arizona is looking for a News Intern. **POSITION PURPOSE:** Native Broadcast Enterprise internships are semester-long opportunities for college students to gain a fuller understanding of the broadcast industry and expand their skill sets. Native Broadcast Enterprise offers one internship opportunity in our News department.

**NEWS/TALK INTERNSHIP CURRICULUM:** This internship is divided into two parts: News Programming and Talk Programming. In news programming, the intern will learn all aspects of the radio newsroom by experiencing it first-hand. The intern will be given the opportunity to pull audio/content, learn how to conduct interviews and create content for on-air and online distribution. In talk programming, the interns will learn the ins and outs of producing a quality talk show while developing and honing talk host skills. The interns will observe and interact with talk show producers and hosts, edit and produce talk show podcasts/interviews, learn how to operate the on-air audio console, help select stories for talk shows, observe the talk show prep process and learn how to screen talk show callers.

Due to COVID-19, the company may require the interns to perform some or all of their learning through virtual means off-site. **REQUIRED SKILLS & EXPERIENCE:** Must be at least 18 years of age. Must be currently registered as a college/university student, eligible to receive internship credit through their educational institution and/or paid internship. Basic computer knowledge.
