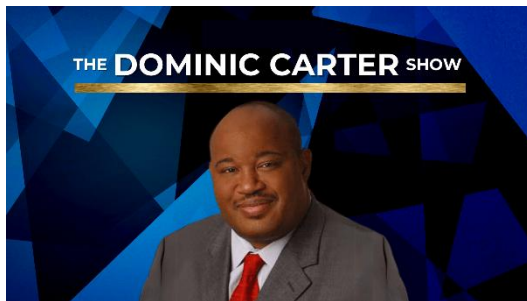




WABC Radio's Dominic Carter Now in Syndication from Red Apple Audio Networks
