Red Apple Audio Networks Expands National Lineup with Weeknight Show from Joe Concha



New York, NY — January 20, 2026 -- Red Apple Audio Networks, the national syndication arm of Red Apple Media, today announced the launch of a new **weekday evening program hosted by Joe Concha**. Titled ***Concha At Night***, the program airs **Monday through Friday from 9:00 to 10:00 p.m. ET** and is available to radio stations across the country beginning next Monday, January 26. ***Concha At Night*** debuted in New York City earlier this month on flagship station **WABC Radio**, one of the country’s most influential talk radio brands.

The expansion follows the strong performance of *The Joe Concha Show* on Sundays, which airs on WABC Radio from 11 a.m. to 12 noon ET, and where the program has quickly gained momentum under the station’s programming leadership. Since Concha took over that Sunday timeslot, he has grown the 12+ New York Metro audience 85% in Average Share and 78% in Weekly Cume, May 2025 to December 2025, according to Nielsen Audio. In addition, the Sunday program is also syndicated as is “Joe Concha Sounds Off,” a hard hitting two-minute weekday feature packed with opinion and punch.

Building on that success, Red Apple Audio Networks will now offer the weekday edition to radio stations nationwide, providing affiliates with a compelling evening talk product.
