She is a member of the Indiana Association of Community Correction Act Counties, where she received the award of Director of the Year in 2015. She is a member of the Washington Rotary Club, project team member for the Hometown Collaborative Initiative Pathway Project, planning team member for the Daviess County Regional Opportunities Initiative Grant and a graduate of Leadership Daviess County. She also attends Bethany Christian Church.

"I believe that my thirty plus years of working with the public in my current position and my terms of service on the Board of Public Works and Safety has given me the knowledge and experiences that will help me lead the City as Mayor. With the opening of I-69, our community is on the verge of the largest economic growth we have seen in decades.
