	Type of Recruitment Initiative (Menu Selection)	Brief Description of Activity
1	Establishment of an Internship Program	In the summer of 2023, our SEU participated in a summer internship program. The 2023 Summer Internship Program was a 6-week unpaid intemship from July 10, 2023 – August 18, 2023, and the intern was a senior student from the University of Louisville. The intern reported to the Promotions Director and gained knowledge and experience in various functions of broadcast radio/media by interacting with multiple departments (i.e. promotions/events, sales, on-air/programming). Examples include creating & scheduling social media posts, calling/interacting with listeners & winners, assisting with errands/signage & prep for upcoming events, on-site experience at station remotes and events, shadowing on-air talent in studio, meeting with leadership to leam about each department, and working with the sales team on planning/execution of promotions & events. At the end of the internship, the intern was hired as a part-time Promotions Assistant.
2	Host a Job Fair	On October 10, 2023 the SEU hosted a virtual career fair. The event was heavily promoted locally to colleges and business groups as well as through on-air and station website advertisements. Participants signed up and were scheduled for an interview with our hiring manager on the day of the career fair, either via phone or Zoom. An informational interview as well as four areas of interest were offered: sales, programming, promotions, and internships. Our hiring manager was available to interact with participants and our SEU was pleased with the interest shown in this event. All participants were offered the chance to apply into SummitMedia's talent-bank for current and future job openings.
3	Participate in a Job Fair	On October 17, 2023, the SEU's Promotions Director attended a career fair at the University of Kentucky to meet with qualified applicants for communication, information, journalism, and media-oriented career and internship positions. The Promotions Director informed interested students about SummitMedia Louisville, collected resumes, and directed students to submit applications through the SummitMedia website for current and future job openings. The SEU was very pleased with the response and participation of this event.
4	Participate in a Job Fair	On March 20, 2024, our SEU's Promotions Director attended a career fair at the University of Kentucky to meet with qualified applicants for communication, information, journalism, and media-oriented career and internship positions. The student learned the daily responsibilities of a GM in the radio business, attended and participated in a Promotions Meeting, and met with Account Executives to learn about their responsibilities and careers in media sales.
