- technology upgrades
- repairs and upgrades to HVAC unit and roofs at various school facilities;
- acquiring school buses and maintenance equipment;
- constructing classroom additions at High Pointe Elementary School;
- parking and traffic improvements at Espy Elementary School and John Thomas School of Discovery; and
- renovating and constructing addition and improvements at Nixa Junior High School and Nixa High School?
