- constructing classroom additions a High Pointe Elementary School;
- parking and traffic improvements a Espy Elementary School and John Thomas School of Discovery; and
- renovating and constructing addition and improvements at Nixa Junior High School and Nixa High School?

If this question is approved, the District's debt service property tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.0666 per \$100 dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
