Shall Lockwood R-1 School District of Dade County, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$2,000,000 for the purpose of improving, renovating, repairing, furnishing and equipping school sites and buildings, including but not limited to, (1) removal and replacement of the roof at the elementary school, (2) replacing windows at the high school and (3) asbestos abatement at the high school?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the District is estimated to remain unchanged from the current rate of \$0.60 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.9900 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

**SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION  
PROPOSITION PIRATES**

Shall the Board of Education of the Ash Grove R-IV School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds to increase safety and security by installing fencing and additional security entry access doors; to repair and/or replace roofs; to improve heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems; to improve traffic circulation; to make District-wide building upgrades; to the extent funds are available, acquire land and complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.7146 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

<p>When the number of candidates filing matches the number of seats to be filled for municipal office, then the citizens of the municipality can vote to have no election pursuant to Section 115.124.1. If you agree for the municipality, the city of Greenfield, to not hold an election when the number of candidates filing matches the number of seats to be filled for municipal office, then vote yes on this question. If you believe the municipality, the City of Greenfield, should hold an election even if the number of candidates filing matches the number of seats to be filled for municipal official, then vote no on this question. If this question passes, it will stay in effect pursuant to Section 115.124.3 for 6 years.</p> <p>Shall the City of Greenfield, Dade County, Missouri Adopt the provisions of Section 115.124.1. RSMo, which provides as follows: "Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, in a nonpartisan election in any political subdivision or special district including municipal elections in any city, town, or village with one thousand or fewer inhabitants that have adopted a proposal pursuant to subsection 3 of this Section but excluding municipal elections in any city, town, or village with more than one thousand inhabitants, if the notice provided for in subsection 5 of Section 115.127 has been published in at least one newspaper of general circulation as defined in Section 493.050 in the district, and if the number of candidates who have filed for a particular office is equal to the number of positions in that office to be filled by the election, no election shall be held for such office, and the candidates shall assume the responsibilities of their offices at the same time and in the same manner as if they had been elected. <p>Shall the City of Lockwood, Dade County, Missouri adopt the provisions of Section 115.124.1 RSMo, which provides as follows: "Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, in a nonpartisan election in any political subdivision or special district including municipal elections in any city, town or village with one thousand or fewer inhabitants that have adopted a proposal pursuant to subsection 3 of this Section but excluding municipal elections in any city, town or village with more than one thousand inhabitants, if the notice provided for in subsection 5 of Section 115.127 has been published in at least one newspaper of general circulation as defined in Section 493.050 in district, and if the number of candidates who have filed for a particular office is equal to the number of positions in that office to be filled by the election, no election shall be held for such office, and the candidates shall assume the responsibilities of their offices at the same time and in the same manner as if they had been elected. If no election is held for such an office as provided in this section, the election authority shall publish a notice containing the names of the candidates that shall assume the responsibilities of office under this Section. Such notice shall be published in at least one newspaper of general circulation as defined in Section 493.050 in such political subdivision or district by the first of the month in which the election would have occurred, had it been contested. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, if at any election the number of candidates filing for a particular office exceeds the number of positions to be filled at such election, the election authority shall hold the election as scheduled, even if a sufficient number of candidates withdraw from such contest for that office so that the number of candidates remaining after the filing deadline is equal to the number of positions to be filled."</p> <p><input type="radio"/> YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> NO</p>
