QUESTION

Shall Logan-Rogersville R-VIII School District issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$24,000,000, estimated to result in no increase to the District's debt service property tax levy, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, renovating, furnishing and equipping school facilities, including:

- constructing an expansion at the Middle School for additional fine and practical arts classrooms
- renovating and improving classrooms and learning spaces at the Upper Elementary School and Middle School
- upgrading and improving roofs, heating, ventilation, and air conditioning throughout the District
- making site improvements of District driveways and parking lots at the Middle School?

If this question is approved, the District's debt service property tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.9394 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION PROPOSITION K.I.D.S.

Shall the Board of Education of the Strafford R-VI School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Sixteen Million Dollars (\$16,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds to expand and upgrade learning environments to support academic growth; to improve District facilities such as the Max Evans Gymnasium, Indian Plaza athletic areas, and the Auditorium with enhanced accessibility and updated public-use features; to make improvements to the agriculture building's instructional spaces; to construct an ADA-accessible playground at the elementary school; to reconfigure parking and traffic flow as needed; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to existing District facilities; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.7000 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
