PROPOSITION EVERTON SCHOOL FACILITY BOND ISSUE

Shall the Board of Education of the Everton R-III School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$950,000) for the purpose of providing funds to expand parking; to upgrade the Agriculture Building; to update and modernize bathrooms; to renovate the cafeteria and dining areas; to upgrade classroom spaces and technology infrastructure; to improve the exterior grounds; and to the extent funds are available, complete improvements; constructing, improving, repairing, renovating, furnishing, and equipping, including maintenance projects at the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.658800 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION PROPOSITION GREENFIELD SCHOOLS

Shall the Board of Education of the Greenfield R-IV School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds to repair and/or replace roofs, upgrade heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems, paint, and replace doors at the Elementary School; to complete masonry tuckpointing, replace windows, and perform asbestos abatement at the Elementary School and High School; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.6750 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
