PROPOSITION

Proposition W.G.: Shall the Board of Education of the Walnut Grove R-V School District, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy by \$0.7900 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation through Tax Year 2040 for the purpose of providing funds for the replacement of roofing, ceiling tiles, windows, window fills, plumbing, electrical, and mechanical systems to the elementary and high school buildings; to renovate the elementary school restrooms; to construct corridors between school buildings and entry vestibules to enhance safety and security; to develop a new drop-off/pick-up lane, sidewalk and parking lot; and to complete other remodeling and repair improvements to existing facilities?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating levy of the District is estimated to increase by \$0.7900 from \$4.0530, currently, to \$4.8430 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for Tax Year 2021 and can be applied to the assessed valuation for each year thereafter through Tax Year 2040.
