Shall Hollister R-V School District of Taney County, Missouri issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$5,000,000, resulting in no estimated increase to the debt service tax levy, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, renovating, furnishing and equipping school facilities, including safety and security improvements at the middle school and acquiring and renovating facilities for use as a central office and for professional development?

If this question is approved, the District's debt service property tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.8207 per \$100 of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
