



Absentee Voting Options

For the 2026 Regular Municipal Election

IN PERSON AT CITY HALL



Qualified electors may vote absentee before the City Clerk at the front office of City Hall beginning Monday, April 20, 2026, from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. The last day to vote before the City Clerk is Monday, May 4, 2026, prior to 5:00 p.m.

BY ELECTRONIC TRANSMISSION (EMAIL OR FAX)



Forms are available at City Hall or at valdezak.gov/elections. Voting by email or fax is conducted during regular hours beginning Monday, April 20, 2026, through the close of polls on Election Day.

THROUGH A PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE



Qualified electors unable to go to the polls due to age, serious illness, or disability may apply for an absentee ballot through a personal representative. This option is available beginning Monday, April 20, 2026, through the close of polls on Election Day. Contact the City Clerk's Office for more information.

ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL



Forms are available at City Hall or at valdezak.gov/elections. It is advised to apply for your absentee by mail ballot at least 4 weeks prior to ensure the voted ballot reaches the City Clerk's Office by close of polls on Election Day.
