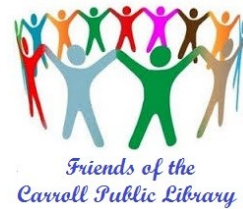

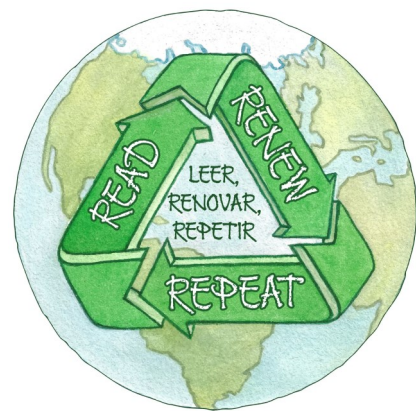

A show constructed to make you roll on the floor laughing. Will shares some of his favorite stories and songs that are loaded with plenty of audience participation.



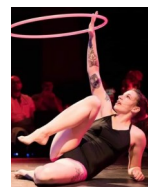
Tues. July 16th: Jolly Pops, Songs and Fun
