



KLAMATH COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

MAJOR WORK FOR THE WEEK OF AUGUST 31, 2026



Klamath County will have work crews at the following locations. Please use caution when in these areas and watch for flaggers. If you are able to avoid the work zones, please use an alternate route for your safety and the safety of Klamath County employees and our contractors.

Campbell Road west of Ivory Pine Road

Traffic is limited to one lane over County Bridge 1210-4 (North Fork Sprague River).

Matney Way between Wong Road and Hill Road.

Traffic is limited to one lane over County Bridge 904-2 (Lost River), with a 10-ton weight limit in effect. No semi-trucks are permitted.

ROAD CLOSED: East Langell Valley Road between Jones Road and Bunn Way including the intersection with Bunn Way – Monday, August 10 through Friday, September 18

Traffic will no longer be allowed through the intersection of East Langell Valley Road and Bunn Way as road drainage improvements begin. See attached map for detour route.

Paint Striping/Stencil Crew

August 31 – September 4 – Miscellaneous County roads.

Intermittent Road Work:

Homedale Road between Harlan Drive and Amberview Lane.

Shasta Way between Winona Way and Austin Street.

Wesgo Drive – Utility Work

Expect lane closures and delays for utility crossings.

Sprague River Road & Bliss Road – Wildfire Activity & Emergency Vehicle Traffic

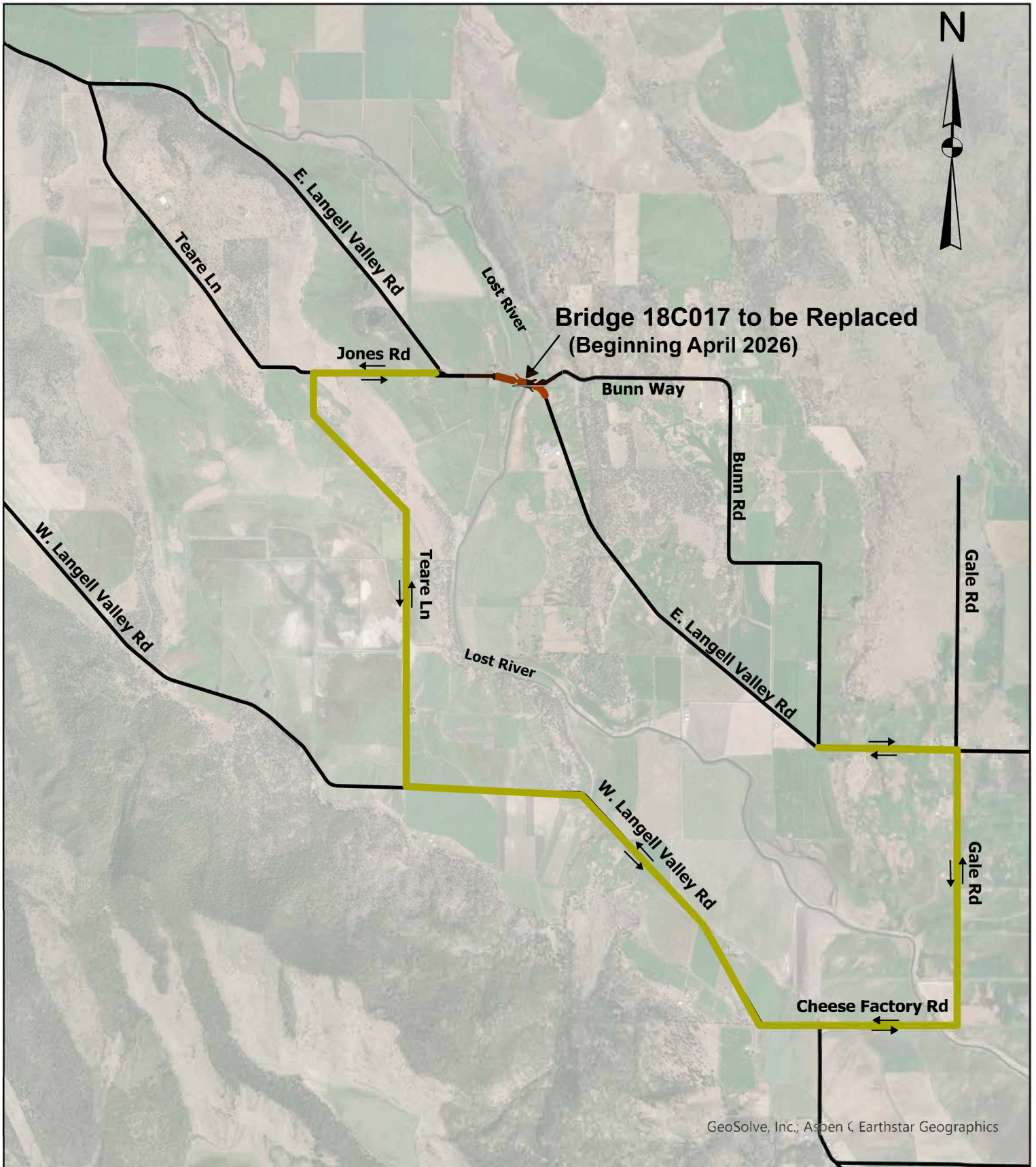
Use caution and take alternate routes if possible.

ROAD CLOSURE: Etna Street south of Anderson Avenue at the irrigation crossing.

Etna street at this location will be closed until further notice due to a collapsed irrigation pipe.

In general, flagging stations will be set up at the end of the work zone and delays will be 0 to 20 minutes for the motoring public. Our goal is to minimize the delay to the motoring public. Other minor work is occurring throughout the County, but we are only listing the major items in this announcement. There may be adjustments of work schedules due to weather or other items outside of the County's control (breakdown of equipment, material/resource availability, etc.) Please do not contact the County if you do not see work occurring, it could be finished already or will be rescheduled.
