

DAY 5 — Thankful for Friends Who Feel Like Family

Verse: *“A friend loves at all times.” — Proverbs 17:17*

There are friends... and then there are *those* friends — the ones who walk into your life and suddenly you can't remember how you ever did life without them.

Friends who feel like family are one of God's sweetest gifts.

They're the people who don't care if your house is messy, if your hair's a wreck, or if you're laughing one minute and crying the next. They stick around for all of it.
